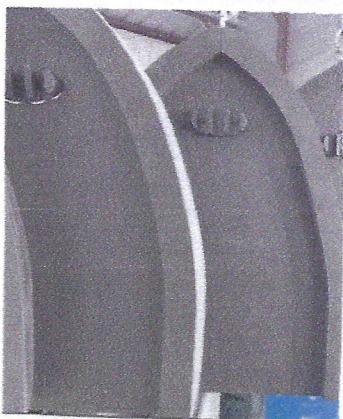
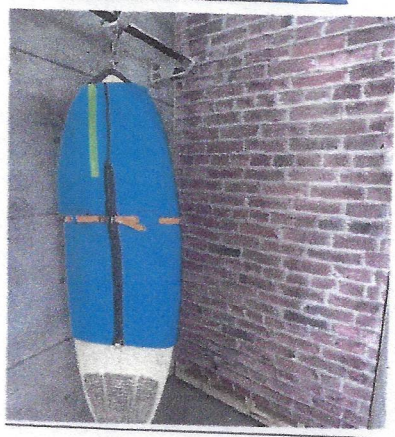




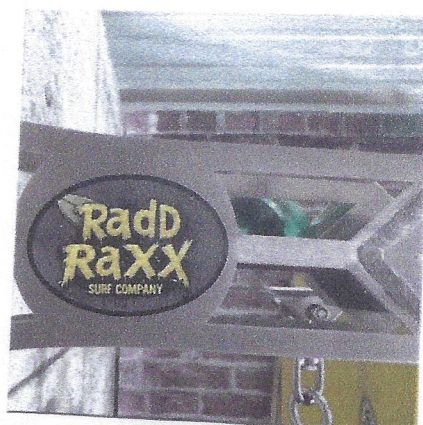
RADD RAXX SURF COMPANY has invented the most innovative surfboard rack system since the Beach Boys. The system lets you hang your boards in a closet, against a wall, from the ceiling and even from the floor. Your boards are protected from dings and damage by a high-density foam cradle against which you easily hang the board, and by a girdle of high quality 5mm neoprene material that wraps around the board. Lift the board in place with the lift leash and tie the leash quickly off around the zig-zag cleat secured to the cradle. Then simply zip the oversized heavy duty zipper tightening the neoprene girdle around your board. For heavier boards, use the snug strap sewn into the girdle to strap it into place. Shown left are the board cradles attached with the hardware and the skate wheel strap.



To the left are board cradles hung from the metal guide. In a space of 48 inches, you can easily fit 8 boards allowing access to them all. To the immediate left are the foam board cradles showing the eye bolt secured to the top of the cradle and the zig zag cleat on the inside.

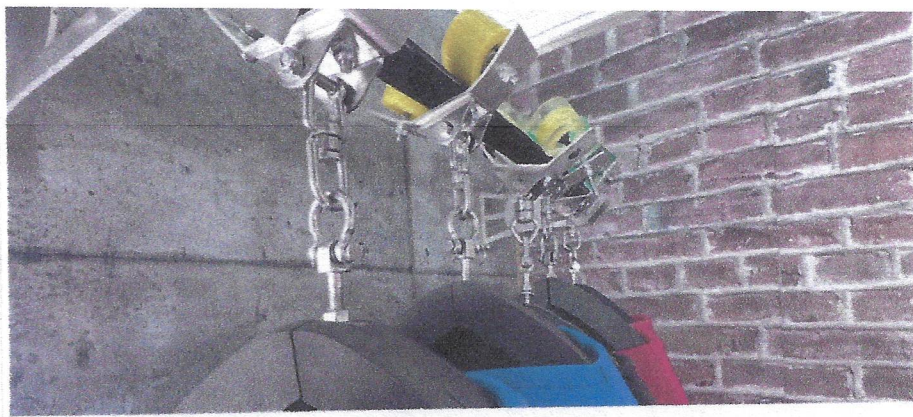
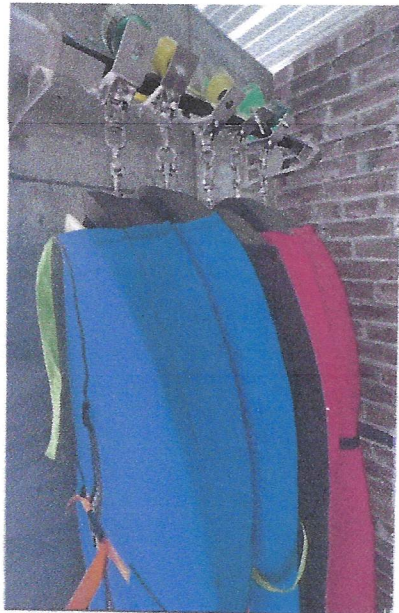


To the right is the bracket that holds the board system in place. Just 12 inches from a wall, the bracket takes up so little space compared to traditional stationary board racks. If you want to install the system using two walls in a closet, the regular bracket does the trick. But if you want to dangle your boards from a wall or a ceiling (or from the floor, call us), this aluminum metal bracket is easy to install give you that flexibility.

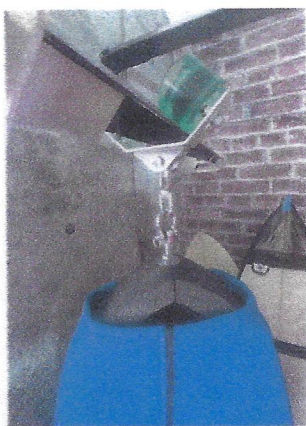


Shown to the left are images of the lift leash which comes with each unit or separate board cradle ordered. The lift leash easily slings over your board grabbing it to permit the surfer to lift the board with the cradle unzipped and hang the leash over the zig zag cleat. The board is against the foam cradle as you zip the neoprene girdle down around the board, holding it in place. See images of unzipped board cradle and zig zag cleat which is attached to the board cradle.

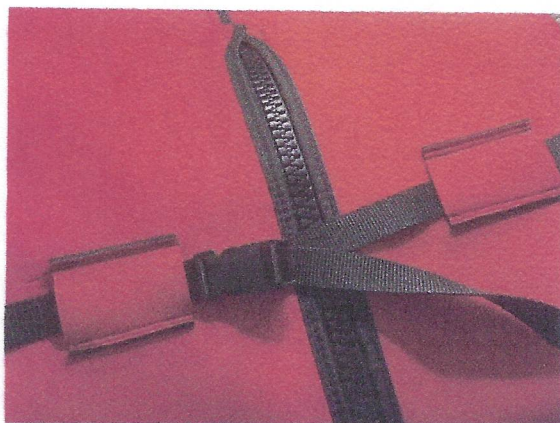




Shown above are three board cradles holding boards from the metal guide track with stainless steel hardware and two skate wheels and bearings that glide easily left and right on the track. The hanging hardware is nearly indestructible and allow the board to be rotated 360 degrees to access other boards.

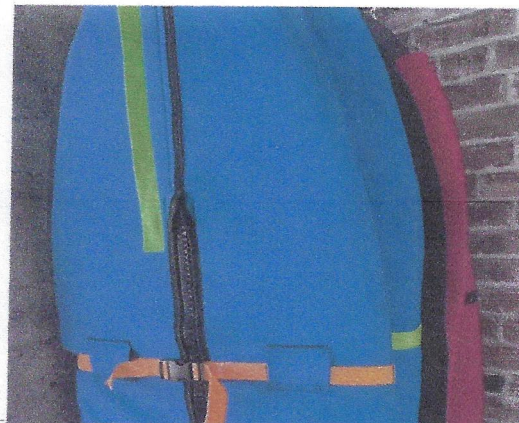


To the left are images of the innovative skate wheel system made from aluminum and stainless steel allows the cradles to ride on two skate wheels with sealed bearings moving smoothly on the top of the guide track. The system swivels 360 degrees, moves laterally and forward and back to allow access to the specific board you need for the day's waves.



The girdles shown below are sewn by a veteran that started his American company his service ended. He made parachute straps and bindings and knows how to make our girdles that wear and last like your life depended on it.
