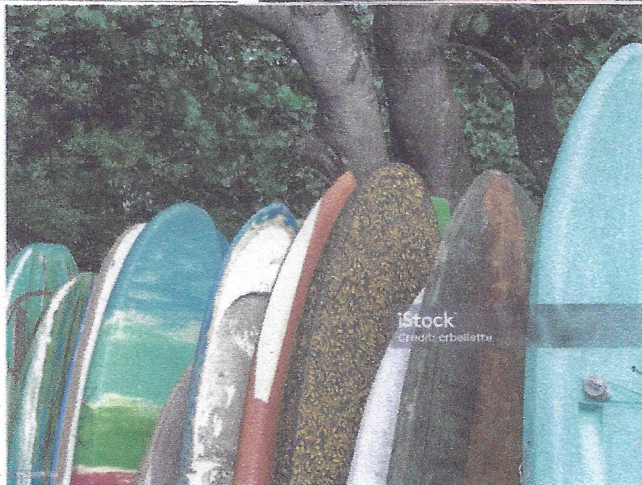

Our system ends the chaos because we looked at the surfboard racks today and blew through the limitations they suffer from. We declared freedom from the chaos for you and your boards.



Let your rack choose where your boards go, or you choose.

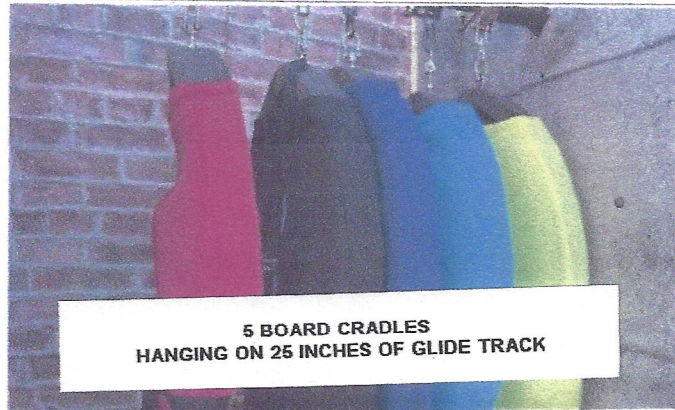
Your current rack is stationary- it sits on the floor, or hangs on the wall, or maybe from the ceiling. You want to place your boards there you need three different racks to accomplish that.

Our rack lets you chose- hang it from the wall, from the ceiling, in a closet and even from the floor. One rack, four options.

Let your rack decide how many boards it will hold, or you decide.

Your current rack holds 1, 2, 3 boards. It is designed to hold a limited number of boards and no matter how many boards you have or acquire, that rack will never grow with your collection. So you end up with a rack too small for your quiver, or with more racks that you have floor space.

Our rack hangs where you want it but expands as your board collection increases. Simply add another board cradle and hardware and slip it onto the glide with your other boards. Problem solved.

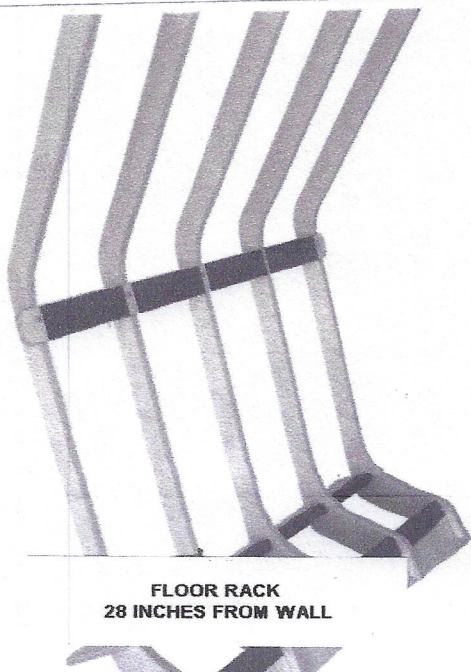


**5 BOARD CRADLES
HANGING ON 25 INCHES OF GLIDE TRACK**

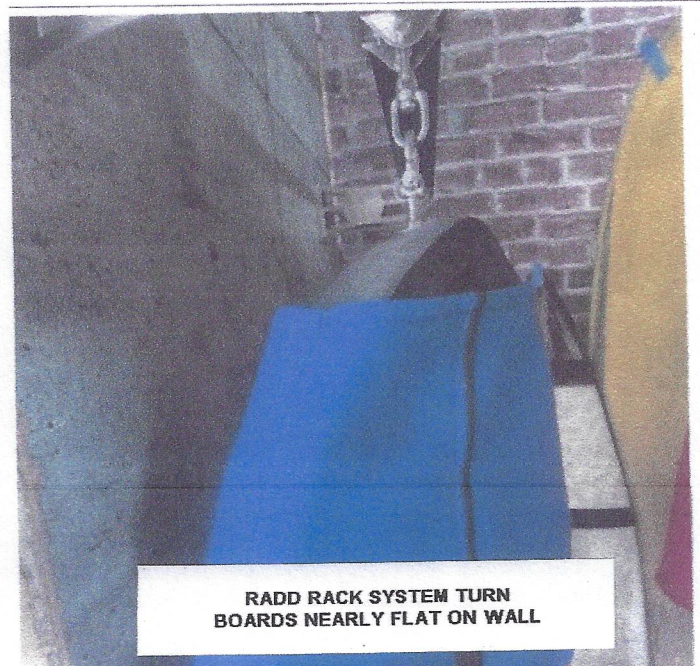
Let your rack take up more space than you have, or you decide that when you're not surfing, your boards will be fine wrapped in protective neoprene, turned adjacent and no more than 12 inches from a wall, hanging around for your next wave.

Worried about your boards taking over your garage or living room. Is your apartment too small to store your boards using the stationary board rack? This 4 board stationary floor rack has dimensions of 56 inches tall, 36 inches wide and 22 inches from the wall. Add the boards to the rack and you lose 10 -12 square feet of living space.

Our rack hangs by stylish brackets that extend a mere 12 inches from a wall. And when your boards are not in use, you simply turn them flat against the wall on their 360-degree rotating hardware. You love your boards, but when you're not using them, put them in their place, out of your space.

Our rack system comes with potential for expansion. Add more boards to the Radd Raxx rack system and never even look at another stationary rack.

Worry about the cost? Stationary racks on the market today can be very cheap or very expensive, but a good way to evaluate their value is by price per board stored. Survey the current market for four board racks ranging from \$250 to the very elegant, but pricey wood models that can set you back \$1500 or more. The average price per board for stationary racks is \$85.00 or more.

Our rack can hold and display 8 surfboards and costs less than \$60.00 per board.
